Recognition:

Other Achievements:

- Having been Team Trainer to the successful Japanese Three Day Event Team who came fifth with all team members going clear in the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta.



- In 1999 Tiny assisted the Swiss team with their preparation for the European Championships.
- In 2000 Tiny was proud to send a horse and rider combination (both of which she trained from novice level) to the Sydney Olympics and watch them put in a very creditable performance including a clear round cross country and finishing 14th individually in the team competition.
- In 2004 Tiny sent her third competitor to the Olympics, an Italian who represented his country in the team competition in Athens and was the highest placed Italian, finishing in the top 25.
- Renowned for her ability to produce top class competition horses. Respected Internationally having sold horses to Belgium, U.S.A., Holland, Spain, Switzerland, Italy and Japan, some of which have gone on to compete at World Championships.



STAY IN THE SADDLE EVENTING CLINICS OUTLINE OF THE DAY

We are proposing to have 4 groups of between 4 and 6 horse/rider combinations throughout the day. Each group will receive 2 hours of tuition from Tiny which will include

- the first hour in a manege/school;/ jumping paddock (depending on the venue)over show jumps
- a break for an hour for your horse and yourself to have a breather, make new friends, have a drink and prepare for the next session. Chance to meet an Equine Lawyer.
- an hour on the cross country course.

The Clinic will start with group 1 prompt at 9 am. It is imperative out of politeness to our hosts and the groups that are following, that we stick to times as much as possible. If you arrive late you will not benefit from the full 2 hours.

STAY IN THE SADDLE EVENTING CLINICS SAFETY MATTERS

Horse riding and eventing, in particular, are risk sports. We want you to improve your riding skills in a safe environment. As equine lawyers we encourage you to assess all risks and minimise the chances of accidents. The clinic aims to prepare you to event at BE level and we therefore recommend that you acquaint yourself with the 2009 BE rule Book at www.britisheventing.com.

All participants at these clinics/training sessions MUST comply with BE Rules and:-

- Wear a crash hat to PAS015 or standard ASTM F1163 at all times when mounted. If not you will not be allowed to participate.
- Wear body protector to level 3 on the cross country course. It is recommended that they are also worn in the first session.
- Advise the organisers, if you have any particular medical condition/allergy.
- Be honest about both yours and your horse's abilities in completing the application form.
- Accept the risk of competing and note carefully the disclaimer in the application form.

We recommend the following:-

- The wearing of gloves.
- Your horse has a neck strap fitted.
- Your horse wears protective boots.
- All tack is checked carefully before participating.
- The use of studs in session 1, if on grass, and on the cross country course.
